Parents will have the ability to monitor their child's grades, attendance and any assignment information securely from their internet browser at home. We are providing this access through our Grade Book Parent Internet Viewer feature. This secured access requires an internet connection and a confidential username and password issued to parents by the school.

Important facts about the Parent Internet Viewer

- Internet access is available to parents at each school's main office.
- You can access the internet viewer by:

- Directions, your login, student's password, parent/guardian password and email address for questions will be :
 - **K-8 school**- given out at parent/teacher conferences in October.
 - **High School**- mailed home by the end of October.

- Your access begins November 5, 2008. After that the Grade Book updates every Wednesday at 5:00 PM.
- You can email your child's teacher directly from the site.
