hello from the Riverview Nurses' office! I hope you had a wonderful holiday! It is that time of year again-Flu season! If your child has the sniffles or a cough it is ok to send them to school, however I wanted to give everyone some guidelines of when not to send your child to school.

Please do not send your child to school if they have the following symptoms:

- a fever of 100.0 or higher**
- vomiting within 24 hours**
- diarrhea**

- pink eye (if your child wakes up with a red eye and they do not have seasonal allergies please do not send them to school. If they have pink eye they need anti-biotic eye drops prescribed by a doctor)**
- sore throat with fever (a sore throat with a fever is probably strep throat and they will need to be seen by a doctor and prescribed anti-biotics)**
- head lice**

If your child is prescribed anti-biotics they may not return to school until they have been on anti-biotics for at least 24 hours. They are still contagious during the first 24 hours.

IMMUNIZATIONS-

If your child goes to the doctor and receives Immunizations please bring us a copy of the Immunization record so we update their immunizations in our office.
